Title:	Minimum settings for the HIKVISION DVR

To ensure proper operation of a HIKVISION DVR you will need to program at least the following items:

- 1) DST (daylight savings time)
- 2) Recording parameters
 - a) Stream type.
 - b) Select "Video" unless you are recording audio also.
 - c) Resolution. Set to desired recording quality
 - d) Frame rate. Optional but must be set to at least 1 frame per second.
 - e) Minimum bit rate of 256 kbps. May need to be adjusted if cameras are "freezing" in the remote viewing software.
 - f) Image quality. Normally set to high.
 - g) Bit rate type. Set to variable.
- 3) Recording schedule
 - a) Must be set to record 24 hours per day seven days per week.
- 4) Network
 - a) Unit IP address Must be set in the same range as other computers on the local network.
 - b) Unit subnet mask This must be set the same for all devices on the local network.
 - c) Unit default gateway This must be set the same for all devices on the local network.
 - d) NTP server Time server to keep the clock correct on the DVR.

- e) Synchronize time interval 12 hours
- f) Time Zone Choose the time zone that the DVR is located in.
