1 Introduction

1.1 Product Features

1.2 Overview




Figure 1-1 Appearance Table 1-1 Description

Notes:

- The indicator in red means the device is standing by. The indicator in blue means the device is on video call.
- Turn on the device after cable connection.

2 Installation

Before you start

- Make sure that the device in the package is in good condition and all the assembly parts are included.
- Make sure that all the related equipment is power-off during the installation.
- Check the specification of the products for the installation environment.
- Check whether the power supply is matched with your power output to avoid damage.
- If the product does not function properly, contact your dealer or the nearest service center. DO NOT disassemble the camera for repair or maintenance by yourself.

2.1 Angle Adjustment




Figure 2-1 Angle Adjustment

The device can be adjusted as shown in Figure 2-1.

2.2 Mounting Methods

2.2.1 Place on the Desktop

You can fold or erect the bracket to place the device on the desktop in the following two ways.




Figure 2-2 Place the Device on the Desktop

2.2.2 Clamp on the Display

You can clamp the device on the display of different thickness.




Figure 2-3 Clamp the Device on the Display

Question: The device is plugged in but the preview software (for example, AMCap 3.0.9) does not show preview image.

Answer: Open Device Manager to check if the web camera is recognized. If not, check whether the device is turned on, or plug the camera in another USB port. When the camera is recognized, open AMCap 3.0.9. Go to the menu and check the device name under Devices and Preview under Options.

Question: The device delivers 4K image in AMCap 3.0.9, but the actual frame rate cannot reach 30 fps in spite of setting the frame rate at 30 fps.

Answer: Uncheck **Use Frame Rate** in **Capture-> Set Frame Rate...** in AMCap 3.0.9 menu.

Question: The device is plugged in but no audio out.

Answer: Check PC settings. Go to Control Panel -> Sound -> Recording, and select the device. Click Properties, and check Listen to this Device.

Question: The device is plugged in but 3840 × 2160 resolution is unavailable, i.e. the device is unable to deliver 4K image.

Answer: USB 3.0 interface is required for 4K video output, and check whether the cable is the original USB cable. If the operating system is Windows 7, download the driver that supports USB 3.0 protocol.

Question: The device is plugged in to the laptop, but the preview image is abnormal or cannot deliver 4K image.

Answer: It may be caused by low battery. Charge your laptop.
