








2.2 Key Description




Key	Description
Numeric Key	0~9. Digits, letters, and characters can be entered in the textbox via the numeric keys. 0 is reused as space bar when no digits enter.
Direction Key	Control four directions: front, back, left, and right.
ESC	Exit key. Exit the current page or return to the previous page.
ОК	In the standby page, hold to enter the administrator login interface, and press to confirm. Used as confirmation and selection key after login.
	Delete key. Delete textbox contents.
4	Input method shifting key.








3.2 Device Wiring

Device Wiring










- When connecting door contact and exit button, the device and the RS-485 card reader should use the same common ground connection
- The suggested external power supply for door lock is 12 V, 1 A
- The suggested external power supply for Wiegand card reader is 12 V, 1 A.
- Do not wire the device to the electric supply directly

3.3 Device Wiring (With Secure Door Control Unit)



- The secure door control unit should connect to an external power supply separately. The suggested external power supply is 12 V, 0.5 A.
- For scenarios with high safety requirement, use the secure door control unit wiring first
- You can ask the technical support to purchase for the secure door control unit separately. • The picture here are parts of the wiring. For details, see the secure door control unit's user manual.

4 Quick Operation

Activation via Device

After powering on, you will enter the activation page

Enter password and press "OK" to confirm password.

- Ti Press" To shift input method.
 - Characters containing admin and nimda are not supported to be set as activation password.

STRONG PASSWORD RECOMMENDED-We highly recommend you create a strong password of your own choosing (using a minimum of 8 characters, including upper case letters, lower case letters, numbers, and special characters) in order to increase the security of your product. And we recommend you reset your password regularly, especially in the high security system, resetting the password monthly or weekly can better protect your product.

Activation via AP

When the device is powered on for the first time, the device hotspot is enabled by default.

You can enable the WLAN on the mobile phone and search for a device hotspot to connect. The hotspot name is AP device SN, and the password is device SN.

After the connection is successful, the mobile phone automatically switches to the mobile Web browser for activation and configuration.

The function is only supported by device with Wi-Fi function.

Steps Afterwards

After activating, you can select language, set password change type, set network parameters, access to Hik-Connect, set privacy, and set

Log in Home Page

Hold "OK", authenticate face, card, or press ▶ to enter the password, and log in the device to enter the home page.

Restore to Factory

Enter the home page, select "System Maintenance"-"Restore to Factory". All parameters will be restored to the factory settings. The system will reboot to take effect.

Tips When Collecting/ **Comparing Face Picture**

Expression

- Keep your expression naturally when collecting or comparing face pictures, just like the expression in the picture on the right.
- Do not wear hat, sunglasses, or other accessories that can affect the facial recognition function.
- Do not make your hair cover your eyes, ears, etc. and heavy makeup is not allowed.

In order to get a good quality and accurate face picture, position your face looking at




Make sure your face is in the middle of the collecting window.








Positions When Colleting/ **Comparing Face Picture**
