- Support naming the captured picture. Right –click on the live view or remote playback window and choose **Other Capture Modes - Custom Capture** to edit its name:

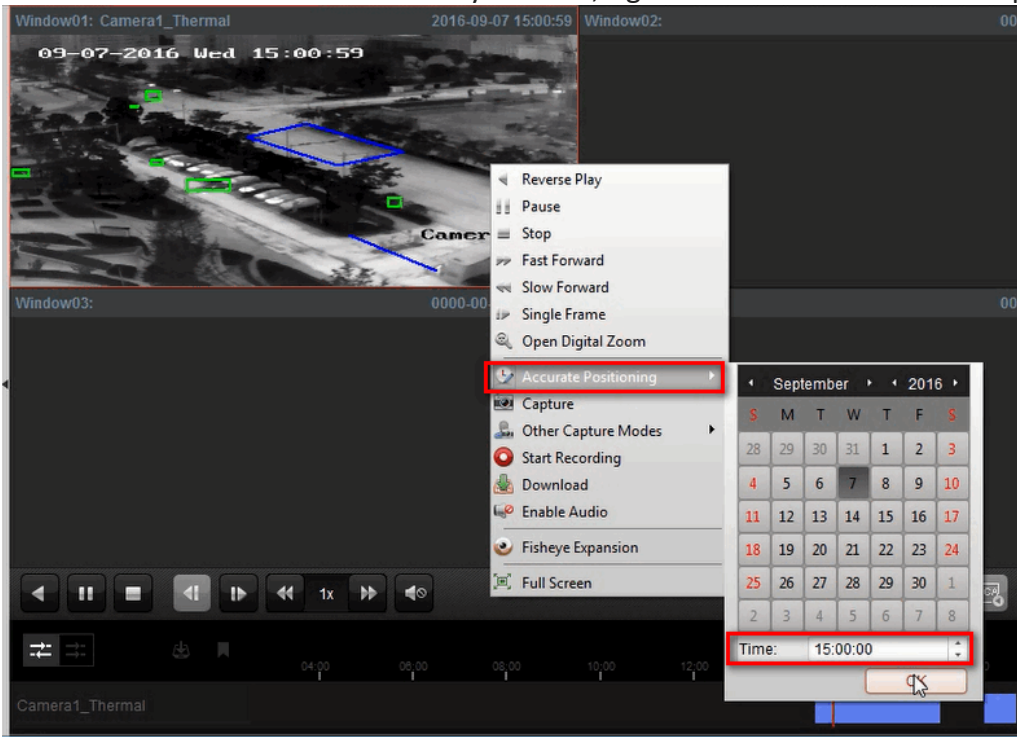

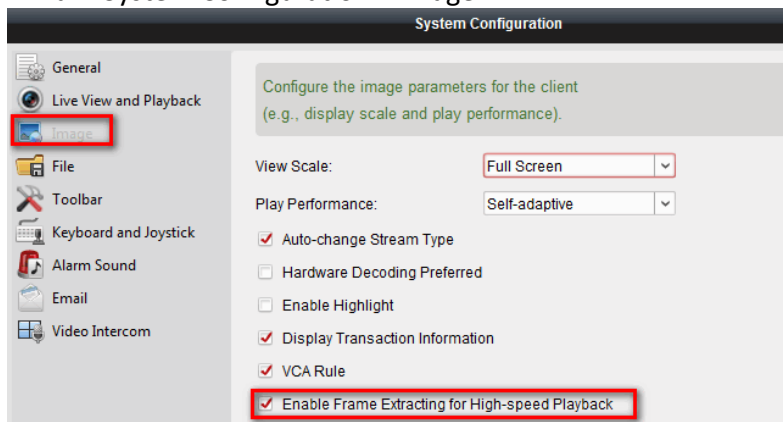

- 3. Extended ability to search video files to 31 days instead of 7 days
- 4. Now support ability to jump to specific date and time
 - a. When on Remote Playback tile, right click and select “accurate positioning”



- 5. Added ability to extract key frames to improve High-speed Playback interface. This is for application when playing back in high-speeds (8X speed and above). You can disable this function to make the image of playback more fluent to view the details.

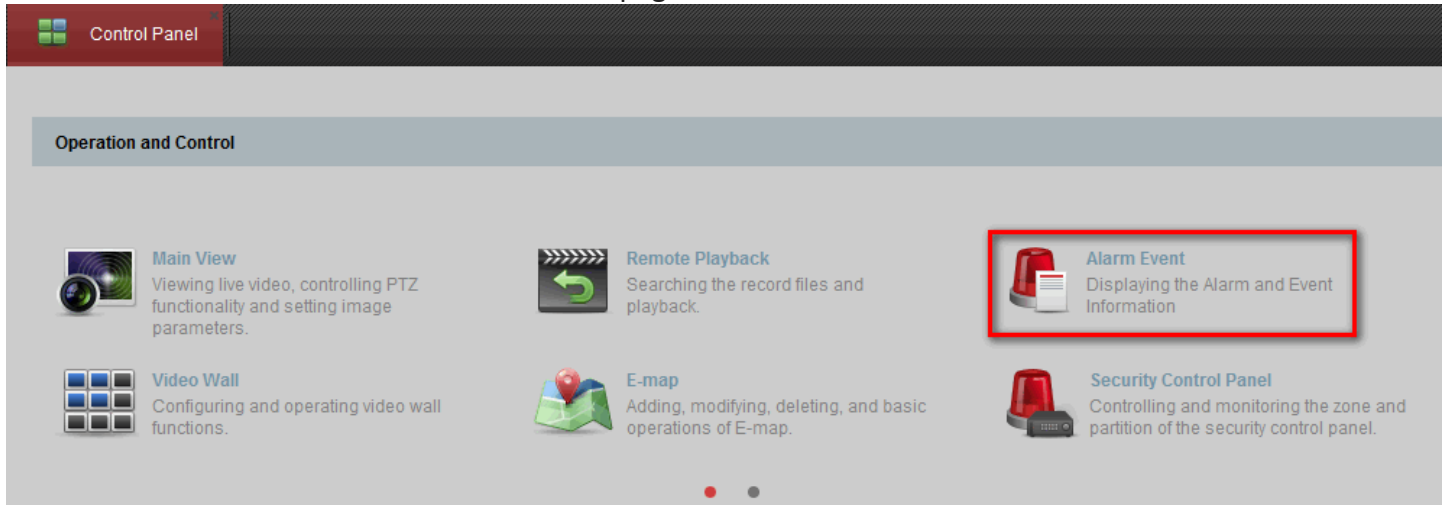

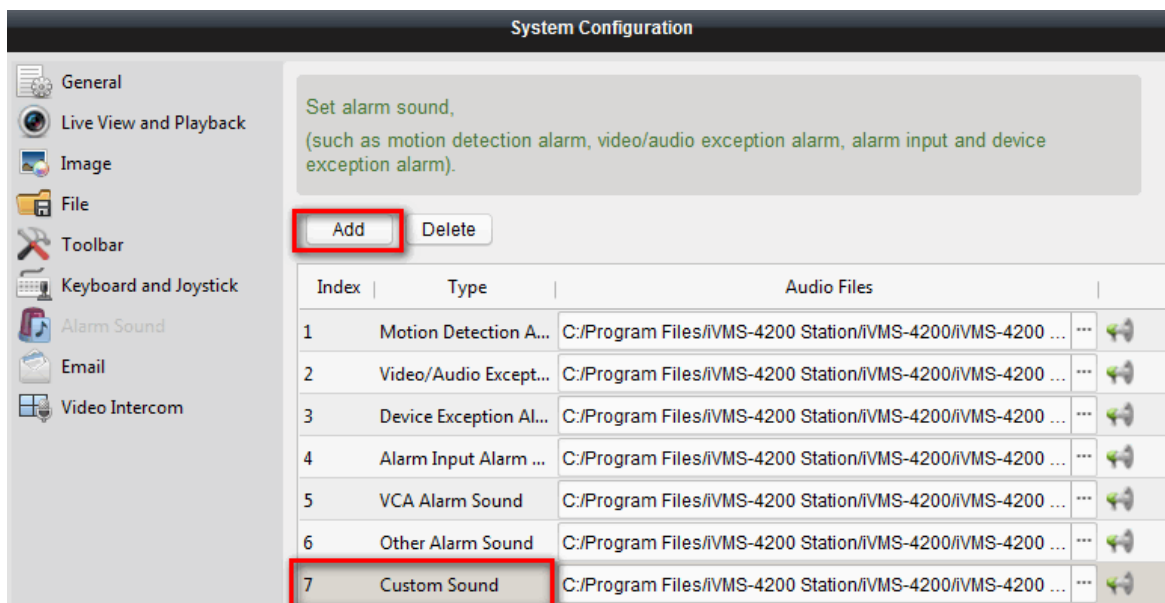
Alarm and Event Management
